Join us as we study with our very own **Laurie Duxbury**. Laurie is a longstanding member of our guild {the former Albemarle Handweavers Guild, and the current Central Virginia Fiberarts Guild} and her popularity as a teacher is nationwide. She has taught at many local and regional workshops – including MAFA and into the national arena at Convergence. Laurie is a patient and thorough instructor and has beautiful creativity and meticulous detail as a master weaver.

The Workshop Details:

Saturday, Sept. 21: Set up 8:30 a.m. Class begins at 9 a.m. and ends at 4 p.m. One-hour break for lunch. Open discussion and extra help 4-5 p.m.

Sunday, Sept. 22. Extra help from Laurie available at 9 a.m. Class begins at 10 a.m. and ends at 4 p.m. One-hour break for lunch. Open discussion and final questions until 4:30 when we pack up for the day.

Location: Hollymead Fire Station: 3575 Innovation Drive, Charlottesville, VA 22911. Plenty of parking is available very close to the meeting room. They have nice bathrooms and a soda machine. No kitchen facility.

Maximum number of students: 15 with pre-warped looms.

Preparations: A supply list and warping instructions will be available in early July. You will need to bring your own loom and have it warped and ready to go. If you have your own weft yarn, bring it too. Laurie will have extra weft yarns available for purchase.

Lunch: Please bring your own lunch. There are some places nearby if you want to pick up – Bojangles, Which Wich, Dairy Queen, Subway, Five Guys, McDonalds, Panera and more.

Costs: Members \$100 + \$5 {paid to Laurie at the workshop} for a handout booklet
Non-members \$110 + \$5 {paid to Laurie at the workshop} for a handout booklet
